**RISK LEVEL**

We remain at **Risk Level 4.**

- Access:
  - All sites remain open and all sites continue to see well and sick visits in a modified format

- Most sites continue to see WCC's into mid-afternoon and are seeing WCC's of all ages
- Some sites are piloting a well only format.
- Screening: Conducted on site each morning by a designated screener which includes a temperature check and risk assessment (symptoms and exposure).
- Self-monitoring: Throughout the day by all staff and providers.

### **COUNTY COVID-19 TRIGGERS**

- Please click the Triggers [Scorecard \(SD County\)](#) to see how San Diego is doing with all 13 of the criteria metrics across the 3 categories. Some triggers are included in the CA Blueprint Triggers below. As of 9/11/2020:
  - SD is failing the community outbreak metric with **17** outbreaks (>7 outbreaks in a 7 day period is failing).
  - SD is also now failing the increasing hospitalizations metric at **14%** (>10% increase measured over 3 days average compared to the average of the 3 days prior).
- CA [Blueprint for a Safer Economy](#) Triggers as of 9/8/2020. Recent heat mapping of case rates show a large increase in the SDSU area as we have noted. Additionally, the coastal areas which were all moderate (orange) have begun to see some substantial (red) and widespread (purple) penetration as of recent.
  - **CA**
    - COVID-19 Case Rate per 100K: 9.1
    - Testing Positivity Rate: 5.3%
  - **SAN DIEGO**
    - COVID-19 Case Rate per 100K: 6.9 (6.9 on 9/11/2020)
    - Testing Positivity Rate: 4.3% (4.5% on 9/11/2020)
    - Tier Status: **Substantial-Tier 2**
  - **RIVERSIDE**
    - COVID-19 Case Rate per 100K: 7.4
    - Testing Positivity Rate: 7.8%
    - Tier Status: **Widespread-Tier 1**
