Re: **Vaccines for all Healthcare Workers**

CPMG/RCHN is pleased to share the information below from the CA Dept. of Public Health. **All healthcare workers, including high, moderate and low risk staff are eligible to receive the vaccine NOW.** This includes all staff, including those who may not have direct patient contact, such as clerical staff.

Please be aware that appointments may not be available at all locations, as today is the first day of the program. Keep routinely checking these links for availability, as more slots are released over the upcoming days.

San Diego County & Riverside County Phases & Vaccine Location Updates

- Health care workers in all three Phase 1A tiers are all now being vaccinated. Employee ID badges (or a letter from an employer) are a must or you will likely not be vaccinated.
 - **Riverside:** offering vaccines at rotating sites where testing has been offered. Please visit <https://www.ruhealth.org/covid-19-vaccine> for days, sites and registration links through the CDPH Calvax vaccination appointment system.
 - **San Diego:** Rolling out regional vaccine POD sites in the North, East, South and Central regions while building up capacity for more. Currently sites administering COVID-19 vaccines by appointment are operational in Escondido, El Cajon and Chula Vista and a newly launched vaccination superstation at Petco Park
 - PODS will operate 7 days a week and by appointments only through the CDPH Calvax appointment system. Please visit:
