

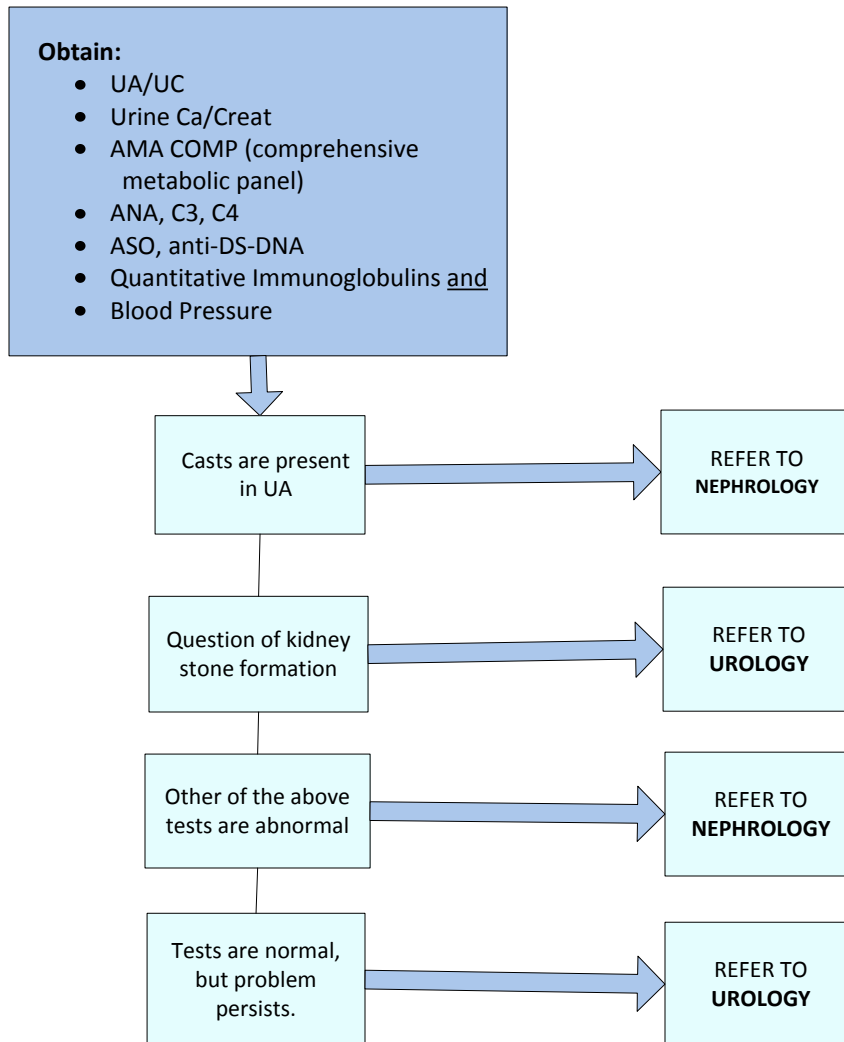
GROSS HEMATURIA

Gross Hematuria



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Workup: Obtain:

- UA, UC;
- Urine Ca/Creat;
- AMA COMP (comprehensive metabolic panel)
- ANA, C3, C4;
- ASO, anti-DS-DNA
- Quantitative Immunoglobulins
- Blood Pressure

When and where to refer:

- If casts are present in UA, Urology suggests a Nephrology, rather than a Urology, consult.
- If question of kidney stone formation, refer to Urology.
- If other tests above are abnormal, Urology suggests a Nephrology, rather than a Urology, consult

If tests are normal, but problem persists, refer to Urology. Urologist will decide what imaging study is appropriate (e.g., CT vs Ultrasound)
